Safety Instructions

1. Please read the instruction manual carefully before installing and using the apparatus.
2. Please save the instruction manual well for reference.
3. Please follow the instructions and aware of warning indications.
4. Except your dealer, please do not use any spare parts recommended by others.
5. Please use the fixing accessories provided by BXB. If the system is broken due to the improper fixing, BXB would not bear the responsibility for compensation.
6. Please make sure the power cord has been fixed properly.
7. Do not use any three-hole plugs or extension cords as this would result in fire or short circuit.
8. Do not stuff anything into the apparatus or splash any liquid on it.
9. Please contact maintenance technicians if the conditions below occur:
 - A. Power cord or plug is damaged.
 - B. Liquid has been spilled into the apparatus.
 - C. The system cannot operate normally even everything has followed the instructions.
 - D. The apparatus fall down or the cover is damaged.
 - E. Other problems that need to be repaired.
10. To reduce the risk of damage caused by lightning strike, it is essential that all cables must be bonded well to the same grounding point.
11. Install the apparatus and its other equipment carefully. Impacting and fierce shaking should be avoided.
12. Do not disassemble or remodel the the apparatus:
 - A. High voltage and sensitive electrical circuit are inside of the apparatus. Do not disassemble it to prevent electric shock.
 - B. The specification of any replaced spare part should be validated by manufacturer, or it may cause fire and short circuit.
13. Do not use the apparatus in the environment with improper temperature, moisture, and power level: the adequate range is 0°C-40°C (32°F-104°F) and 90% below of moisture.
14. Do not expose the apparatus to rain and moisture. Put it in a dry location to avoid any damage of the inside components.
15. Do not clean the apparatus and its accessories with chemical detergent. Use a cloth dampened a little bit water instead.
16. Do not switch on/off the power of apparatus rapidly no matter it's operating or off. It can maintain the regular operation of the sensitive electronic circuit.

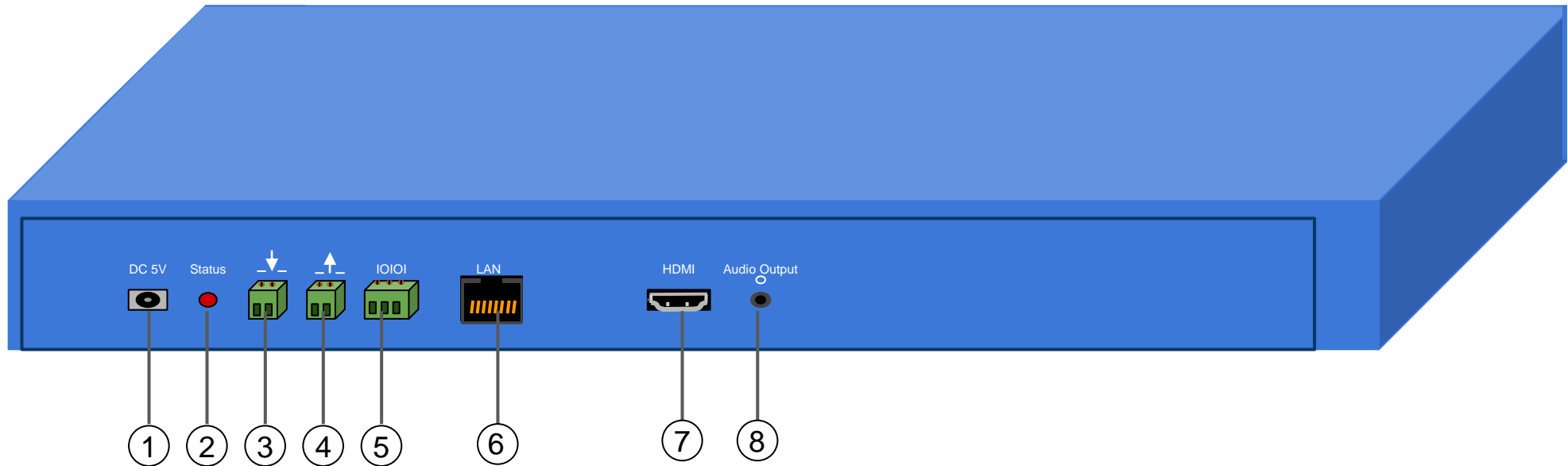

Warning: Only qualified maintenance technicians can disassemble the cover of apparatus.

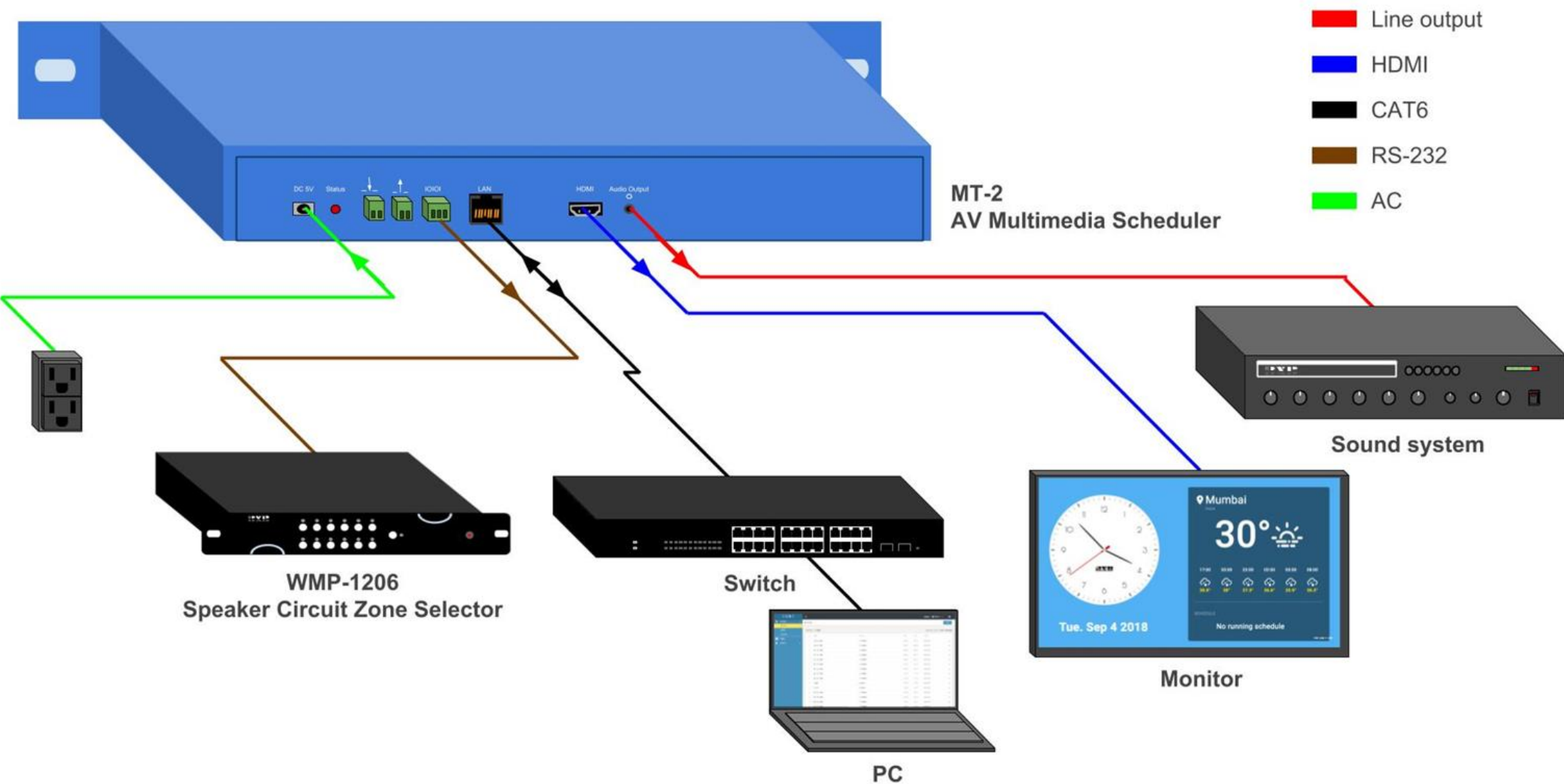


Rear Panel



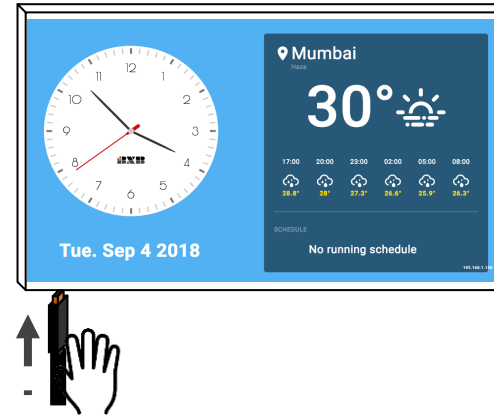
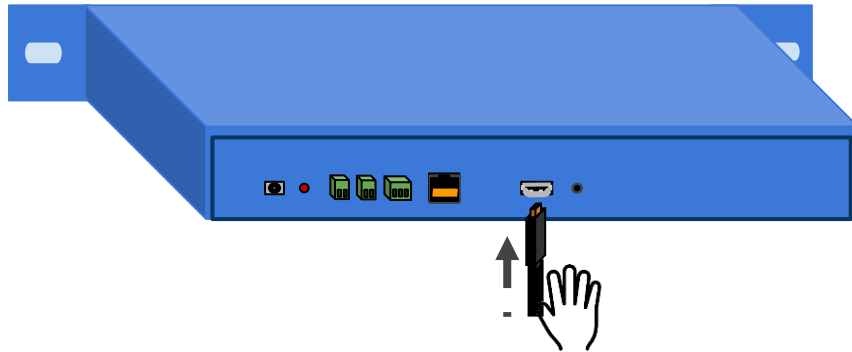
- ① **Power Supply:** connect with AC100-230V to DC-5V adapter.
- ② **Power Status Indicator:** turn on when the power status is normal; turn off when there's the abnormal condition of power supply.
- ③ **Trigger Contact IN:** the preserved contact.
- ④ **Trigger Contact OUT:** N.O. trigger contact for connecting with other equipment such as an amplifier. It enables the equipment to switch on.
- ⑤ **RS-232 Port:** the pin from the left to right is GND, TX, RX. For connecting with BXB's WMP-1206 Speaker Circuit Zone Selector.
- ⑥ **Internet Port:** you can set the schedule, system configurations, and NTP clock via Internet.
- ⑦ **HDMI OUT:** connect with screens for displaying weather & air quality information and scheduled messages.
- ⑧ **Audio OUT:** enable to connect with PA system. As the system is executing broadcasting, the sound could come out from this linear source or the HDMI port for mixing output.

Notice: all functions would work normally only by connecting with the Internet.

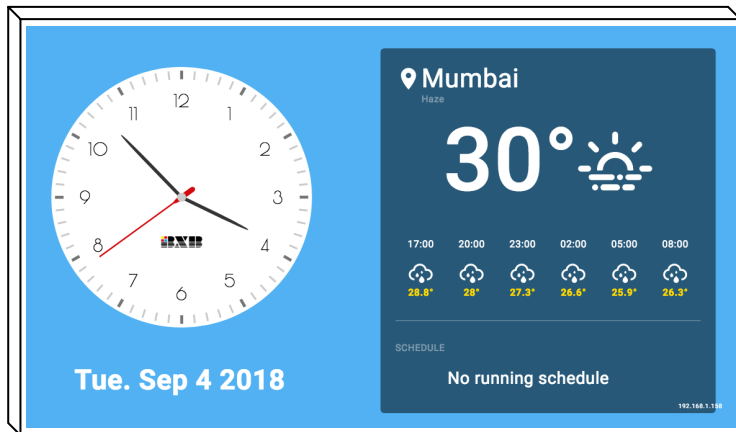


By connecting with the monitor, MT-2 can display the scheduled messages and the weather information from the Internet.

You can select horizontal or vertical display based on the way of installing the monitor.

Connect MT-2 and the monitor with HDMI cable and switch the monitor channel to HDMI.

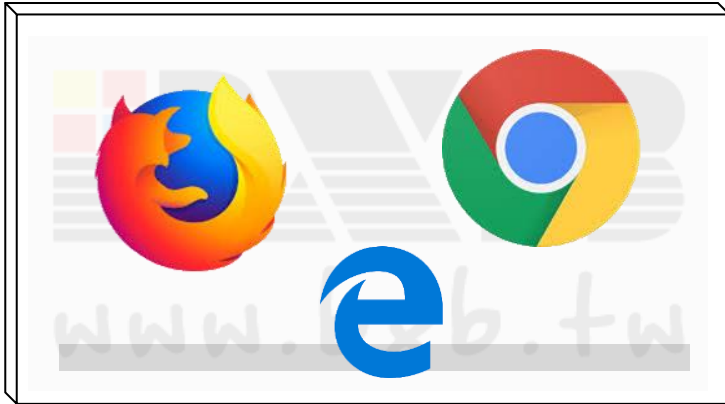
As the earthquake occurs, BXB's server would send out the warning messages automatically. Beside audio warning, the text messages can also be displayed on the monitors for instant action and evacuation.

MT-2 enables the information visualized, making you manage the information quickly and conveniently.

Via the Internet, MT-2 can show the information of local time, weather, and air quality.

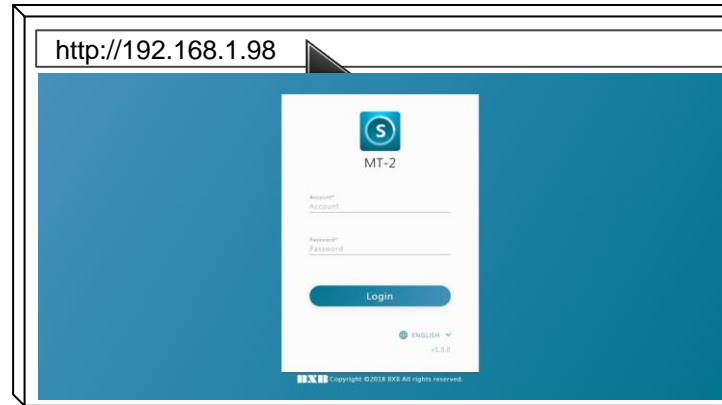
Remote Control- Log in

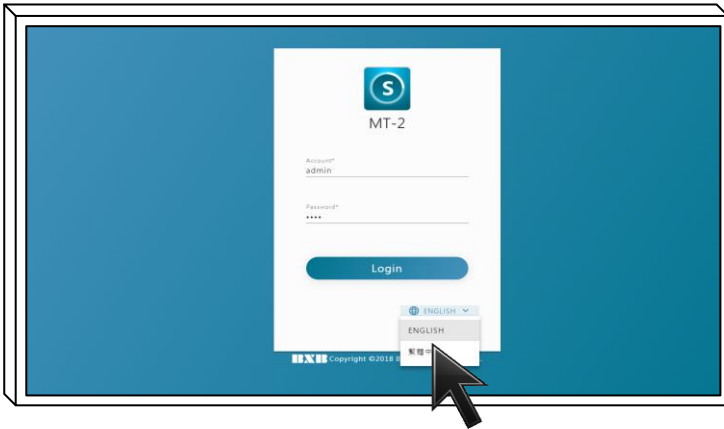
Select a web browser and open a window.

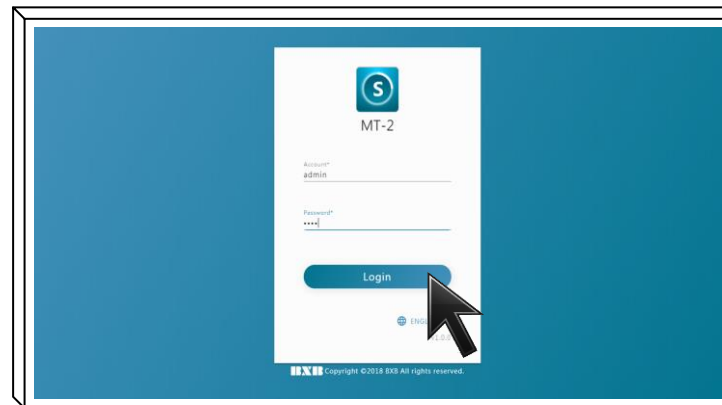
Key in the MT-2's IP address on the URL bar.

You can select Traditional Chinese or English on the log-in page.

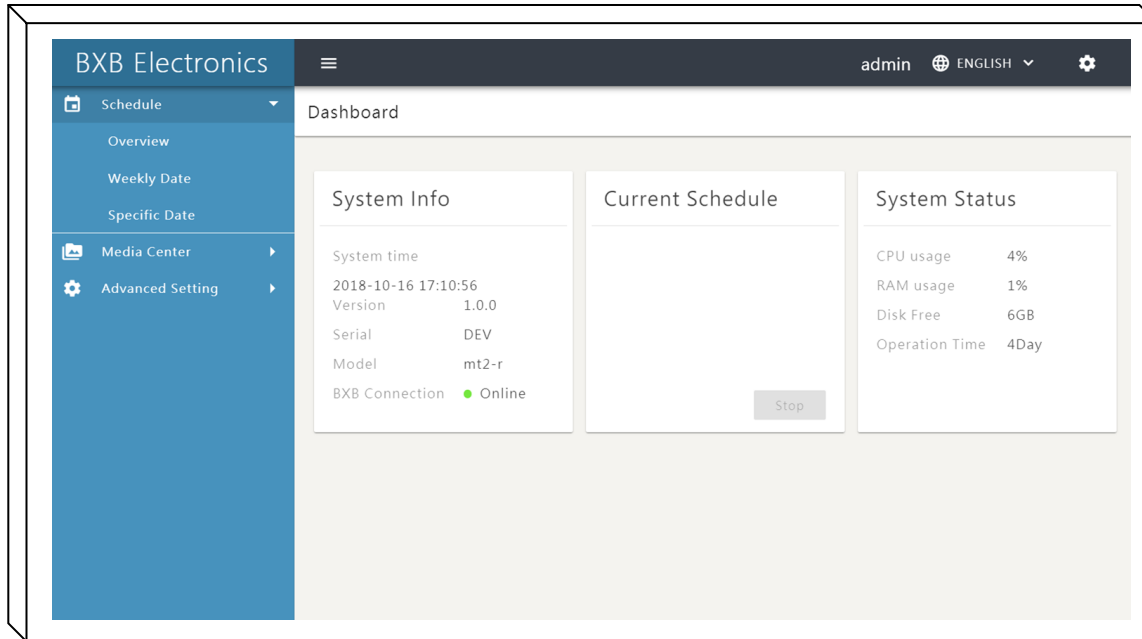
Key in the account number and password to log in.

The IP address of MT-2 can be set as DHCP or fixed IP. If you can't make sure the IP address, just watch the screen from HDMI output to get the present IP address.

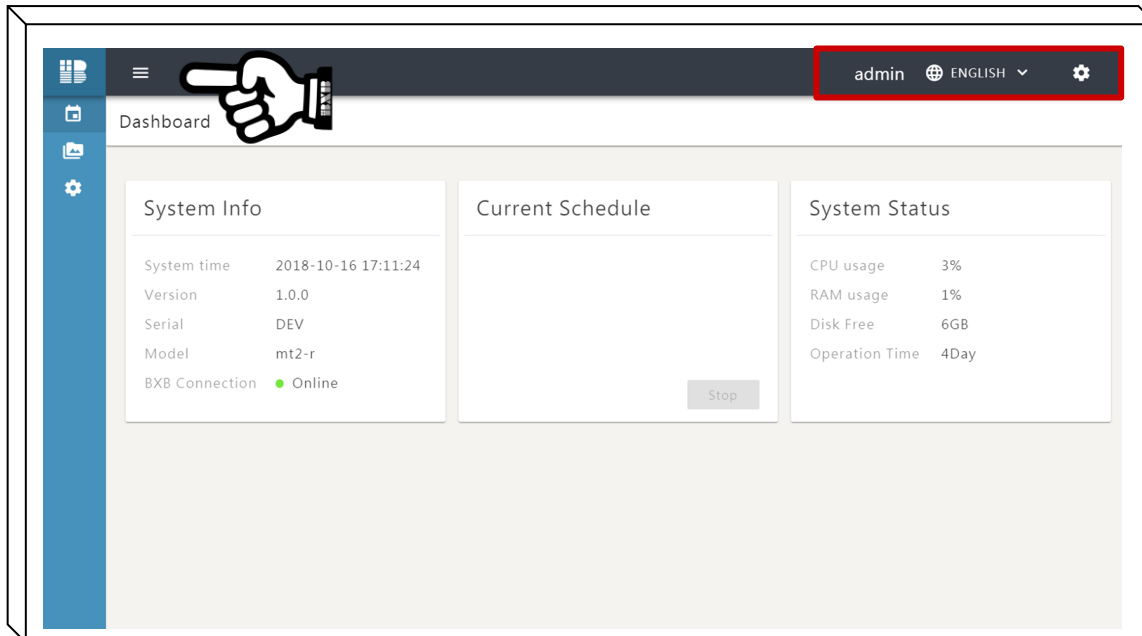
You can remote control MT-2 via the mainstream web browsers such as Chrome, Microsoft Edge, and Firefox. Just key in the MT-2's IP address to enter the login page.

The default account number is "admin"; password "00000". If you want to make the revision, just go to "Account" of "Advanced Setting" after logging in.

Remote Control- Dashboard



From MT-2's dashboard, you can see the information such as connection status, system version, CPU/RAM usage, and current schedule. It facilitates the administrator understanding the system status remotely.

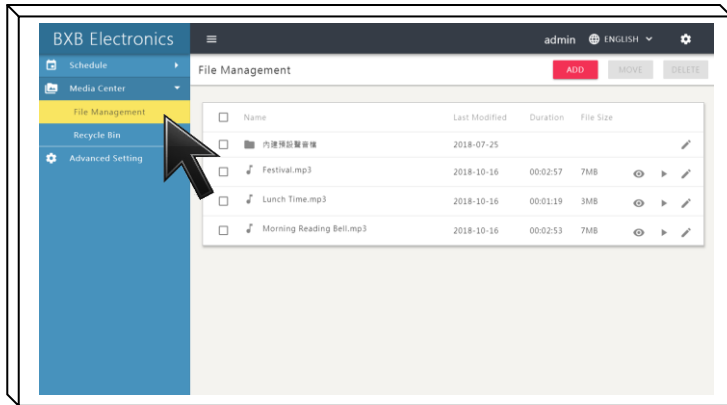


Each setting item is listed on the left task bar. You can show/hide the bar. If you want to change the language or revise the account number, just check the upper right items for the setting.

Click 「☰」 to show/hide the task bar.

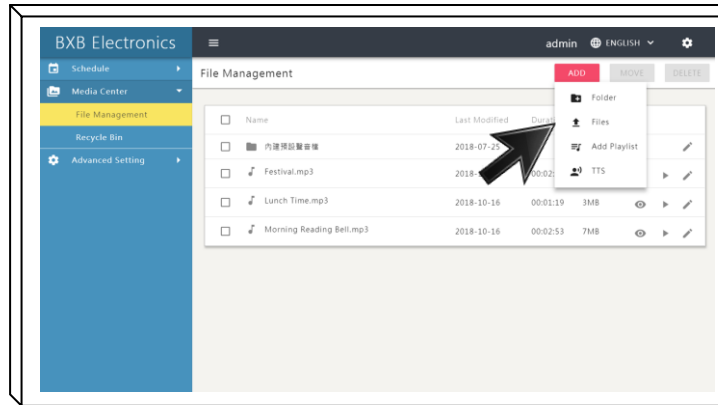
Media Center- File Management

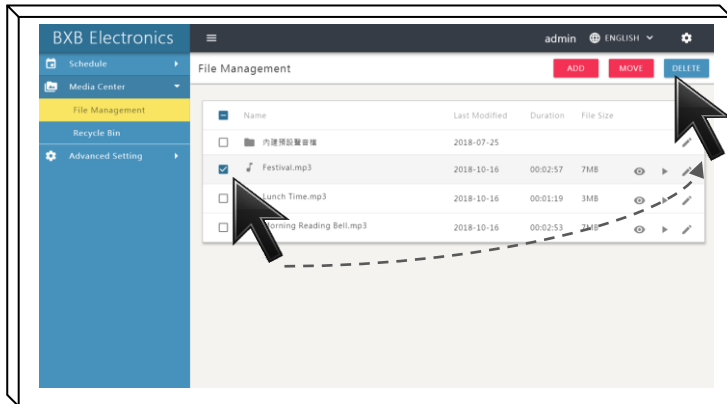
Click “Media Center”

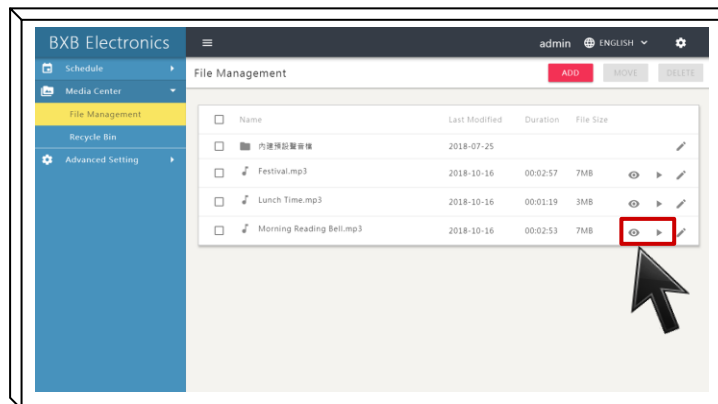
Click “ADD” to add multimedia files.

Preview or play the music/video.

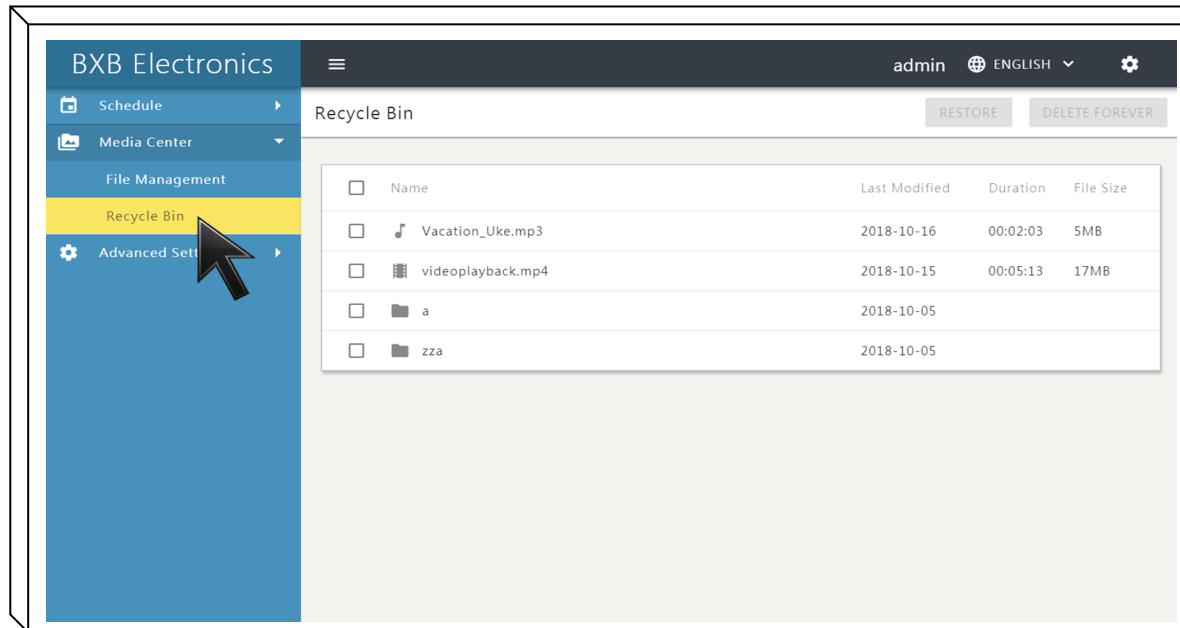
You can add, delete, preview, and play the multimedia files on “File Management”, which makes schedule arrangement more convenient.

Support uploading the files with MP3, MP4, and WAV formats. However, MT-2 only executes audio broadcasting. If you upload the video with MP4 format, you can still preview the video but only could hear the audio as MT-2 is executing broadcasting.

MT-2 is built-in with TTS function. You can enter the texts in advance. The system would transform the texts into audio messages with male/female voice.

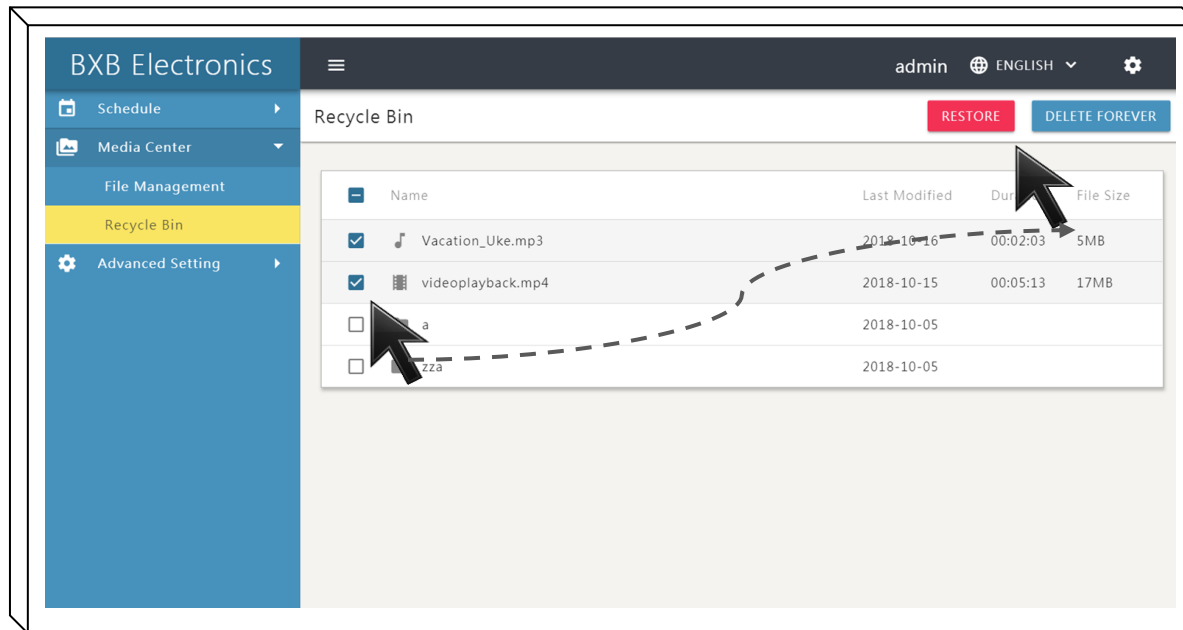
For playing multiple audio files, add the files to “Playlist” and set the play mode as “Sequence” or “Random”.

Media Center - Recycle Bin



The files deleted from “File Management” would be saved in the “Recycle Bin” temporarily.

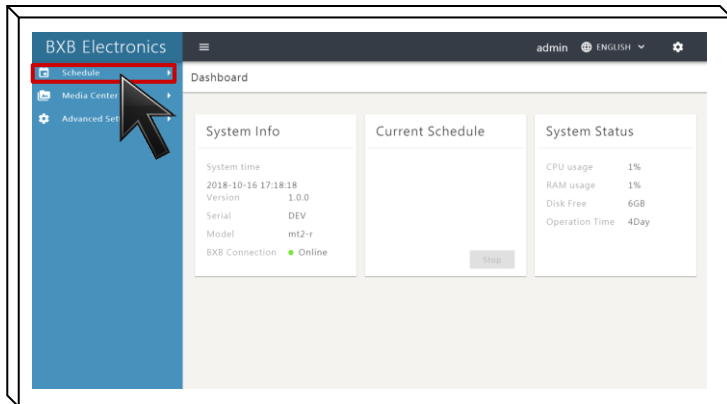
You can click “RESTORE” to restore the deleted files back to “File Management” list.



However, if you select “DELETE FOREVER”, the files couldn’t be restored anymore.

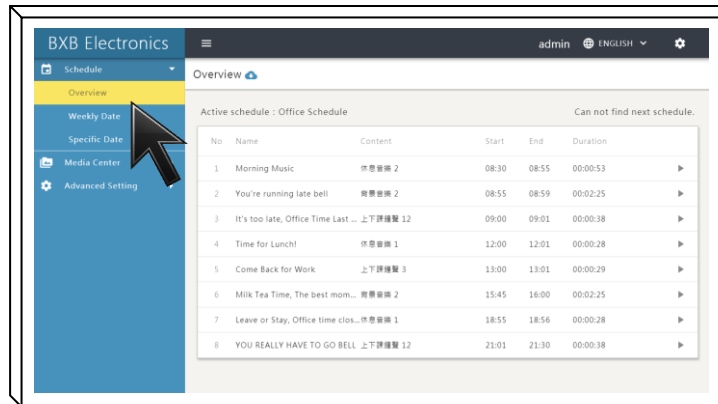

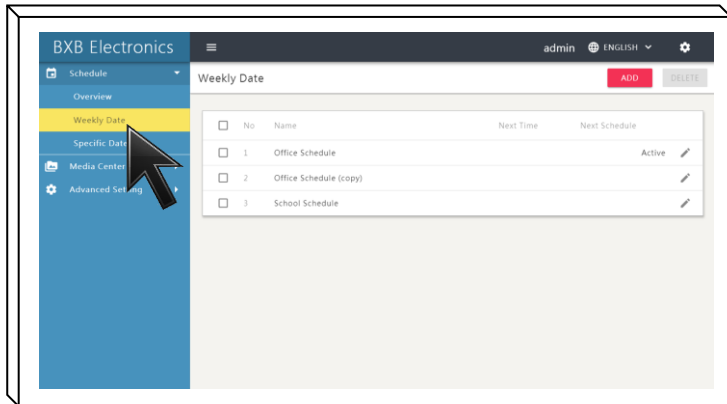
Click "Schedule" to arrange each schedule.

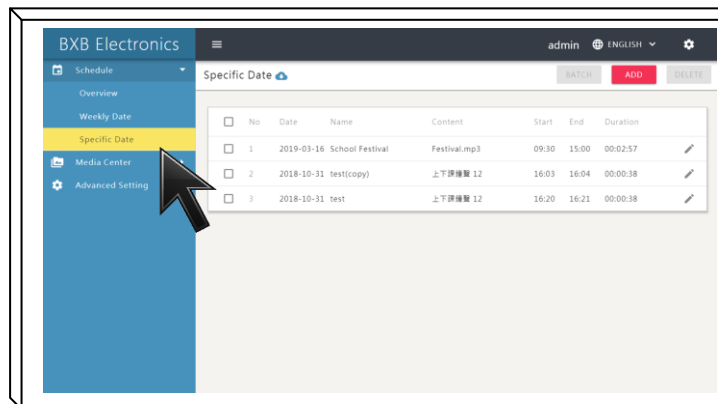
Click "Overview" to see today's schedules.

Click "Specific Date" to set/manage the schedule of specified dates.

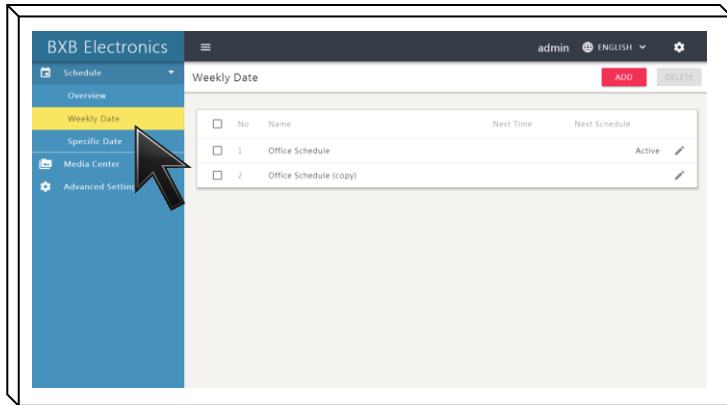
There're three setting pages for schedule arrangement: "Overview", "Weekly Date", and "Specific Date".

"Overview" page: you can see the schedules for today's broadcasting as well as execute/terminate the schedules right away. All schedules can be exported as XLSX format and then saved for future use.

You can edit the weekly schedule and set specific dates as your broadcasting basis.

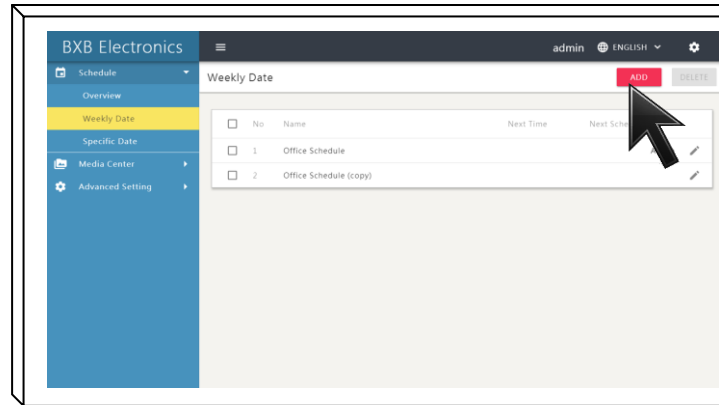

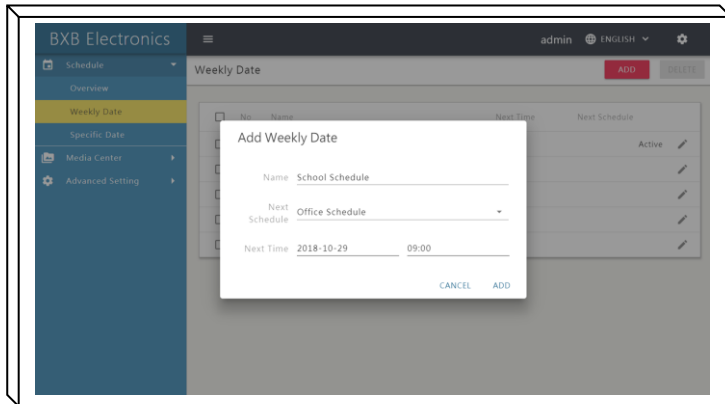
Click “Weekly Date” for schedule setting and management.

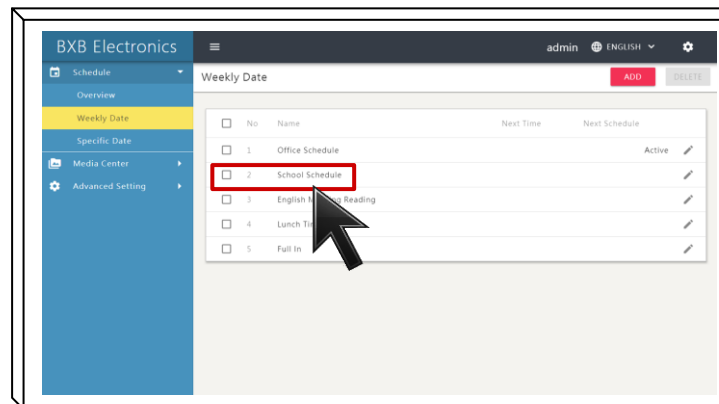
Click “ADD” to add a blank schedule.

After finishing the setting, the weekly schedules would be shown on the list.

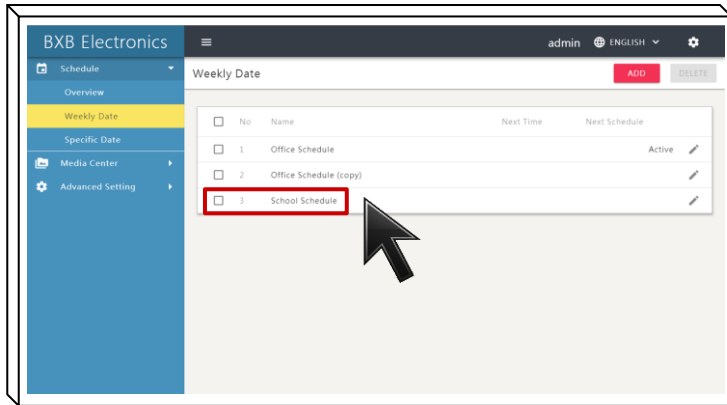
Based on the class or working timetable, you can edit the schedule with adding multimedia files such as MP3 or TTS.

You can add multiple schedules and use the “Next Schedule” function. The system would automatically switch the next schedule based on the time you’ve set so that you don’t need to switch manually.

If you didn’t set “Next Schedule” function, the system would execute the broadcasting based on the present schedule.

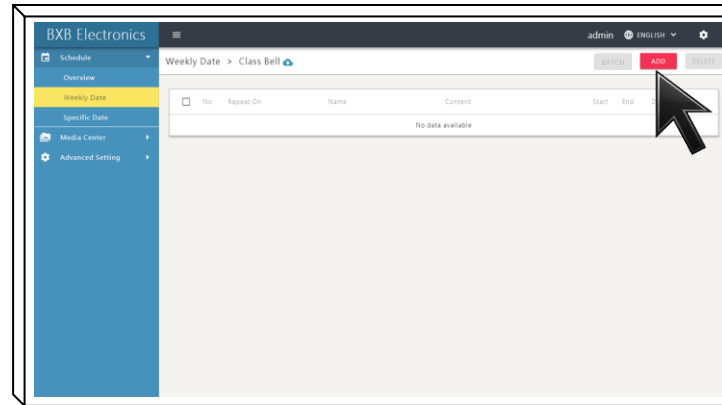

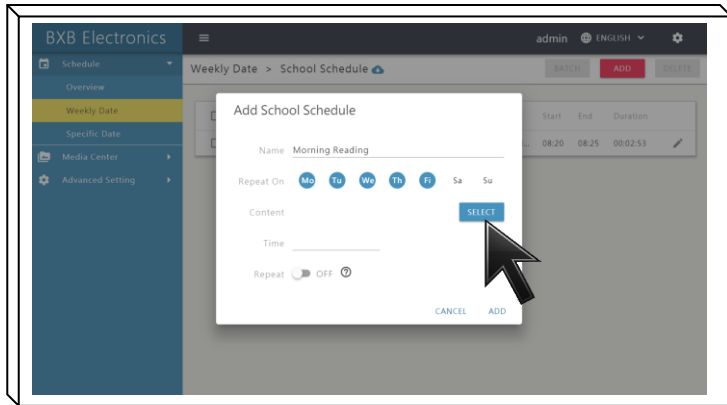
Select the day of week. Eg., select **Mo** for executing broadcasting every Monday.

The equipped calendar makes the date & time setting more convenient and intuitive.

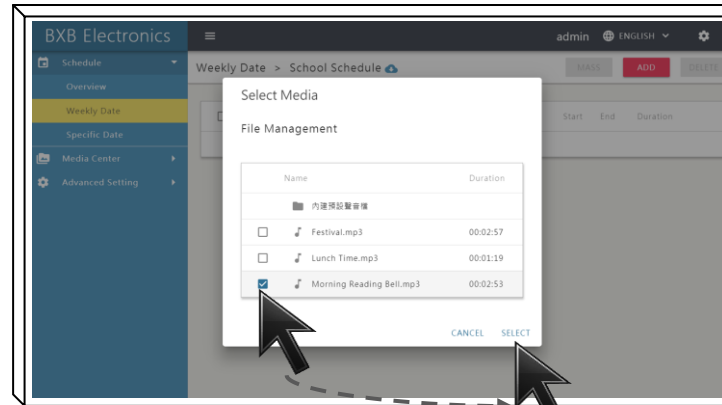

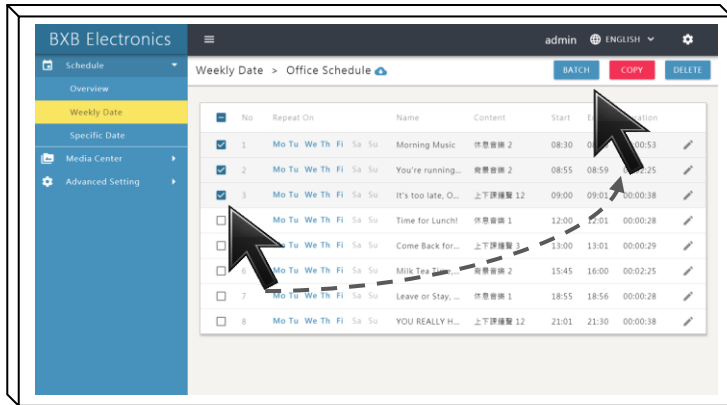


Click "ADD" to add the schedule successfully.

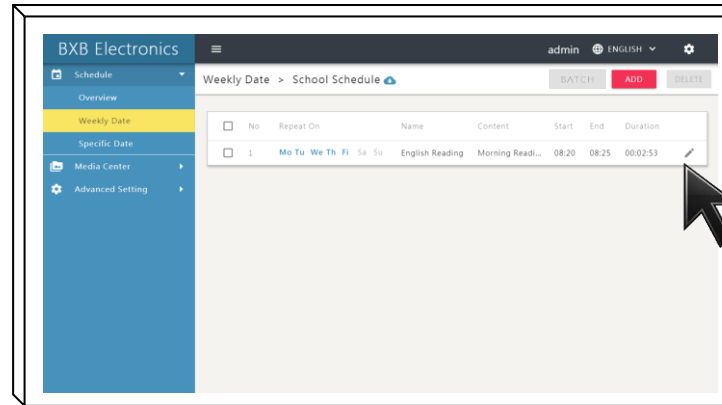

Check the schedules and click “COPY” or “DELETE”. Click “BATCH” to change the broadcasting day of multiple schedules at once.

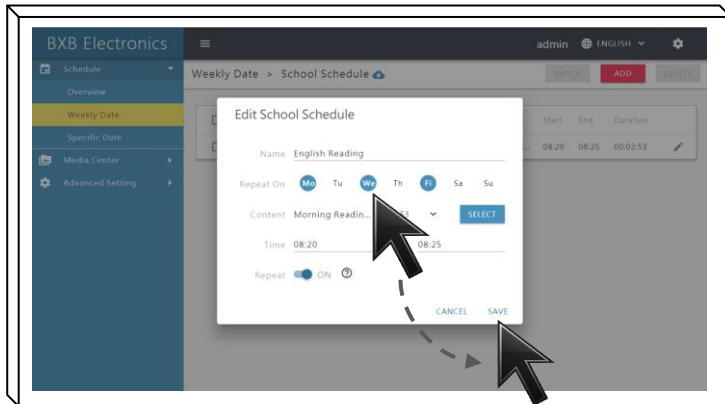

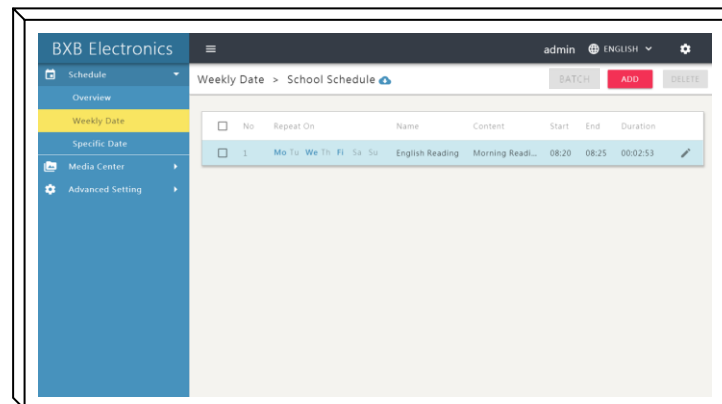

For example, if today's schedule has both the "specific date" for mid-term exam bell and "weekly date" semester, the system would only ring the mid-term exam bell.

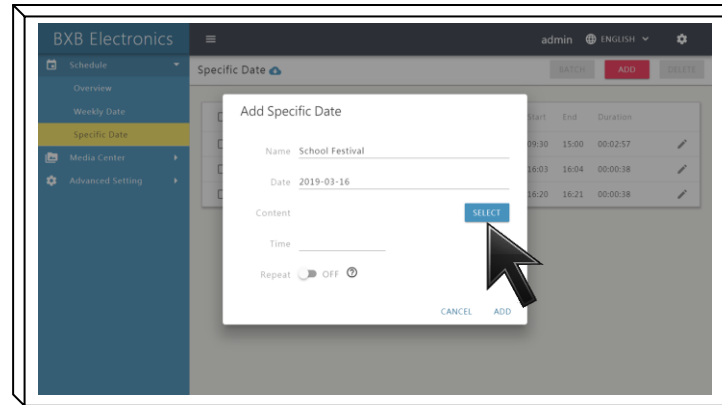

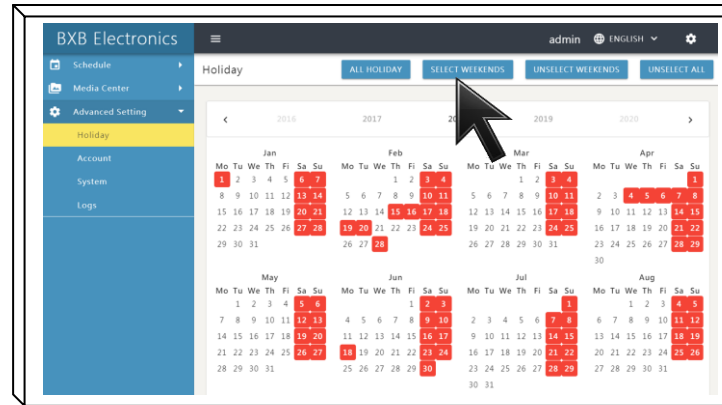
Advanced Setting- Holiday

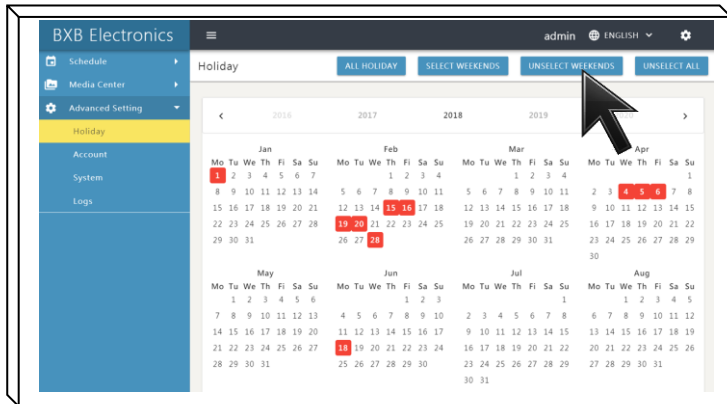
Click “Advanced Setting” and select “Holiday”.

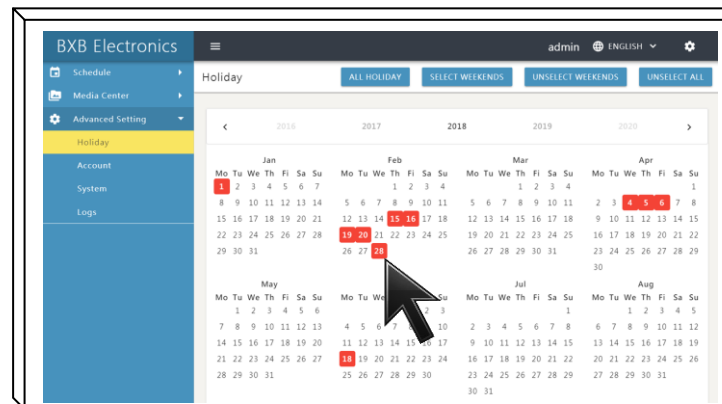
Click “ALL HOLIDAY” or “SELECT WEEKENDS” for batch setting.

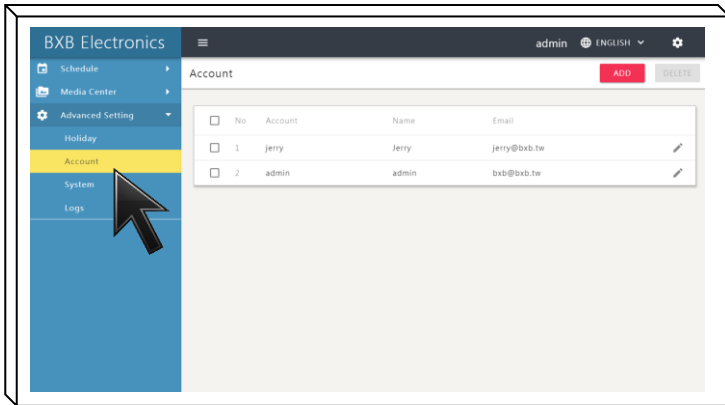
Click a specific date on the calendar for not executing broadcasting.

Via “Holiday” setting, the system would update the calendar automatically. You can also select a date on the calendar for not executing broadcasting.

For example, on the day of 28 February, there’s a weekly schedule. However, it’s the holiday, so the system would not execute the broadcasting on that day.

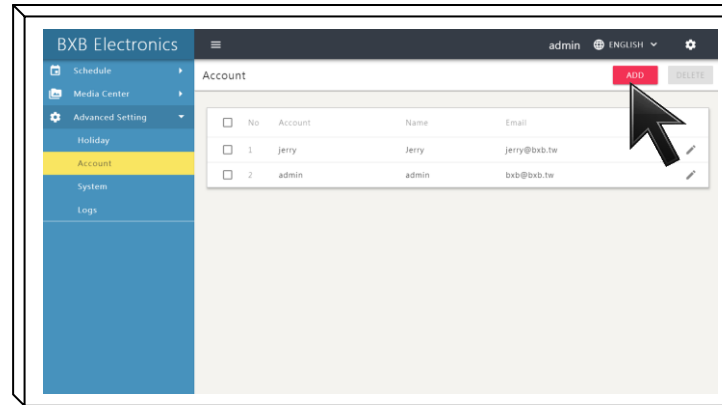
Advanced Setting- Account

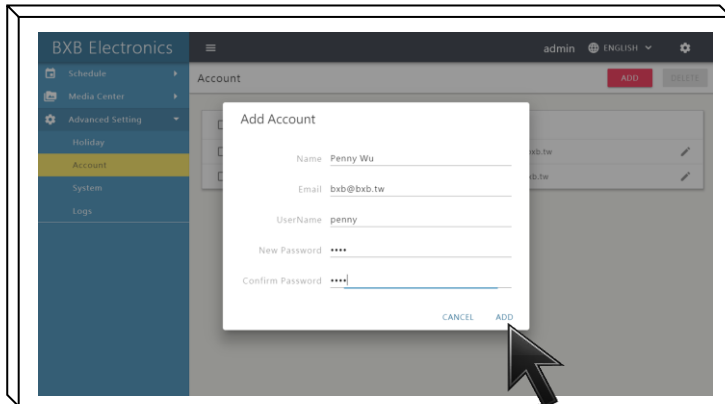
Click “Advanced Setting” and select “Account”.

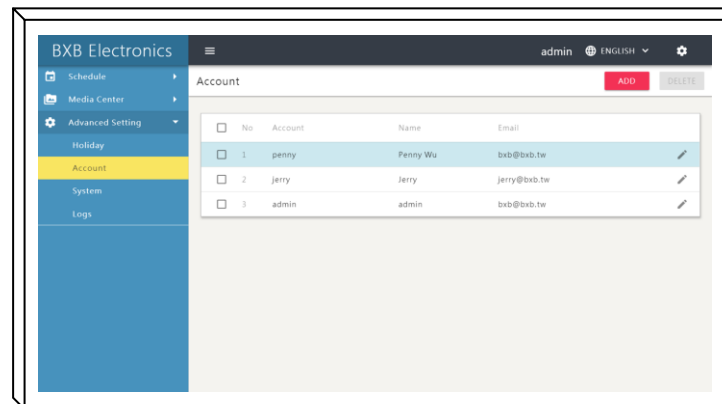
Click “ADD” to add a new account and password for remote login.

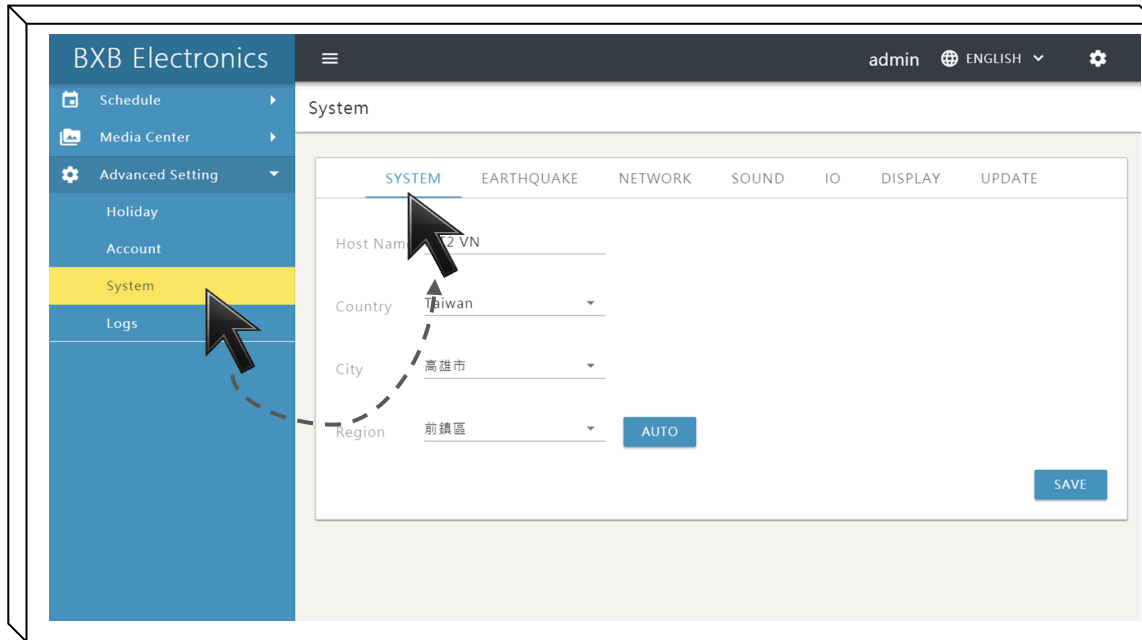
The new user’s account and password have been added to the list.

Via LAN, the users can control and edit the setting on the web interface with the PC or mobile devices.

MT-2’s default account / password is admin/00000. The administrator can add new ones for other users.

After logging in, the new user can click the  icon on the upper right corner of the page to change the password.

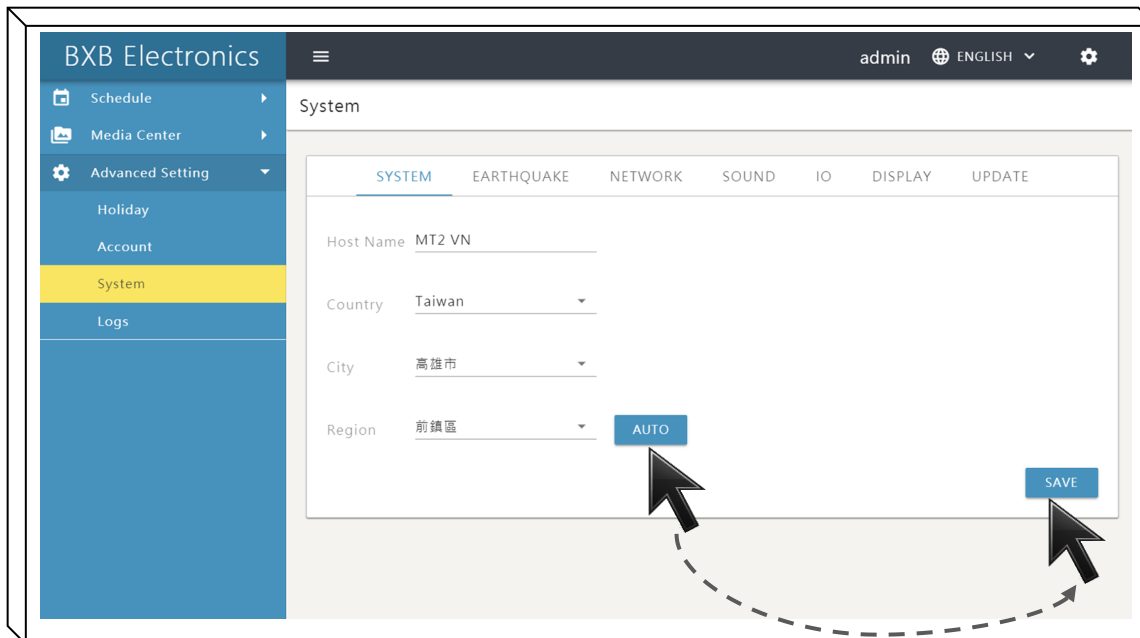
The “Account” setting can only be seen and operated by the user of the default account (admin).



You can change the name of MT-2, which enables the users easily identifying the equipment for remote login.

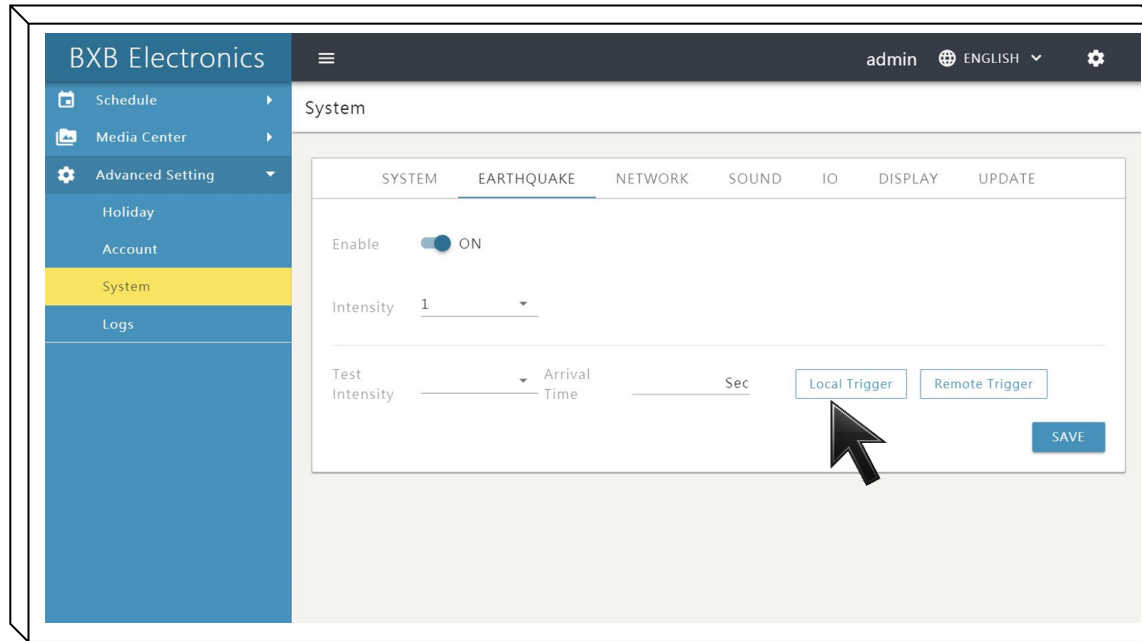
The setting of “Country”, “City”, and “Region” would affect the information display of weather, air quality, and the earthquake warning.

Via Internet, the system can automatically position the present location. You can also manually set the location information.

Advanced Setting- Earthquake

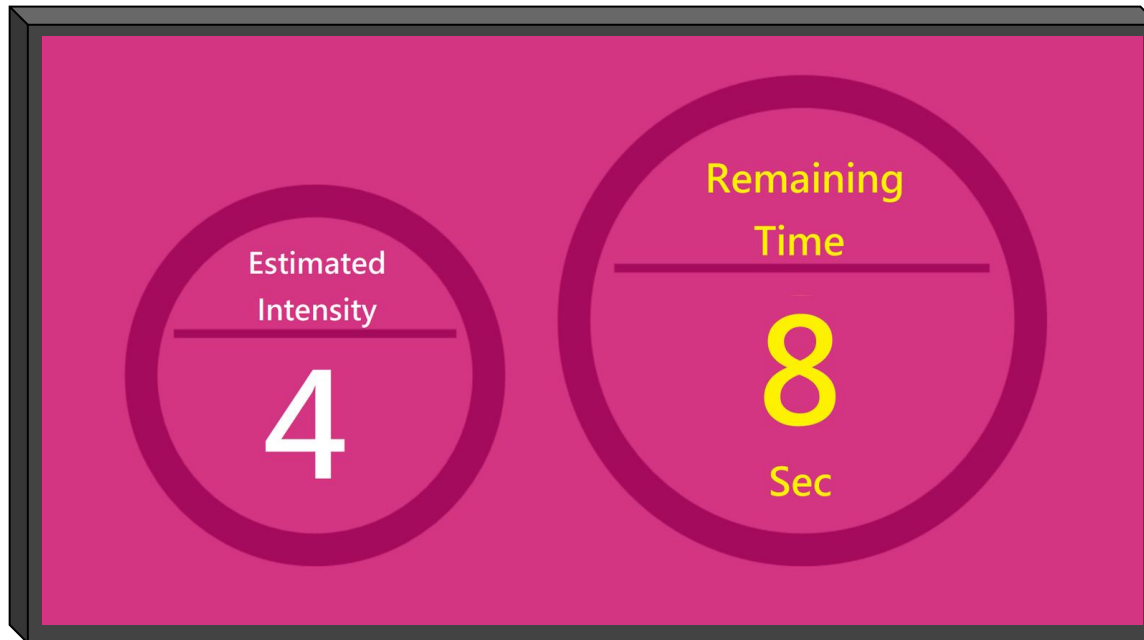


Via earthquake setting, BXB's server would announce the warning messages before the earthquake occurs.

There're two modes for earthquake rehearsal simulation: Local Trigger and Remote Trigger.

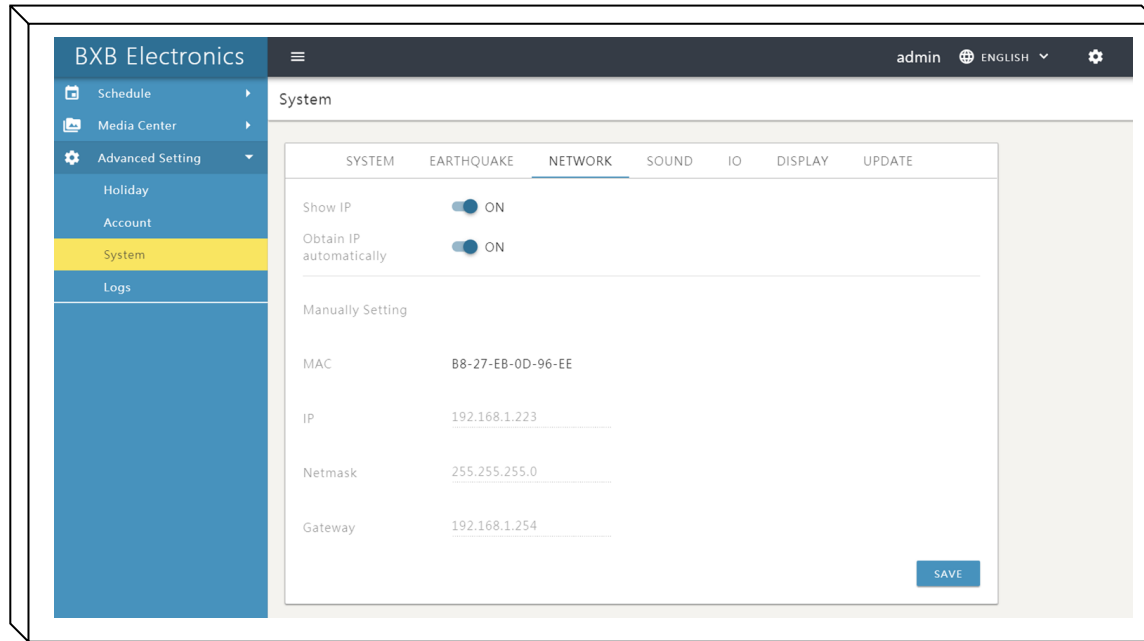
Local Trigger: executing the rehearsal by the local MT-2. Remote Trigger: the server should be connected with the Internet and then send back the messages to execute the rehearsal.

Beside the warning sound, the information of intensity and seismic waves can be shown on monitors via HDMI output.



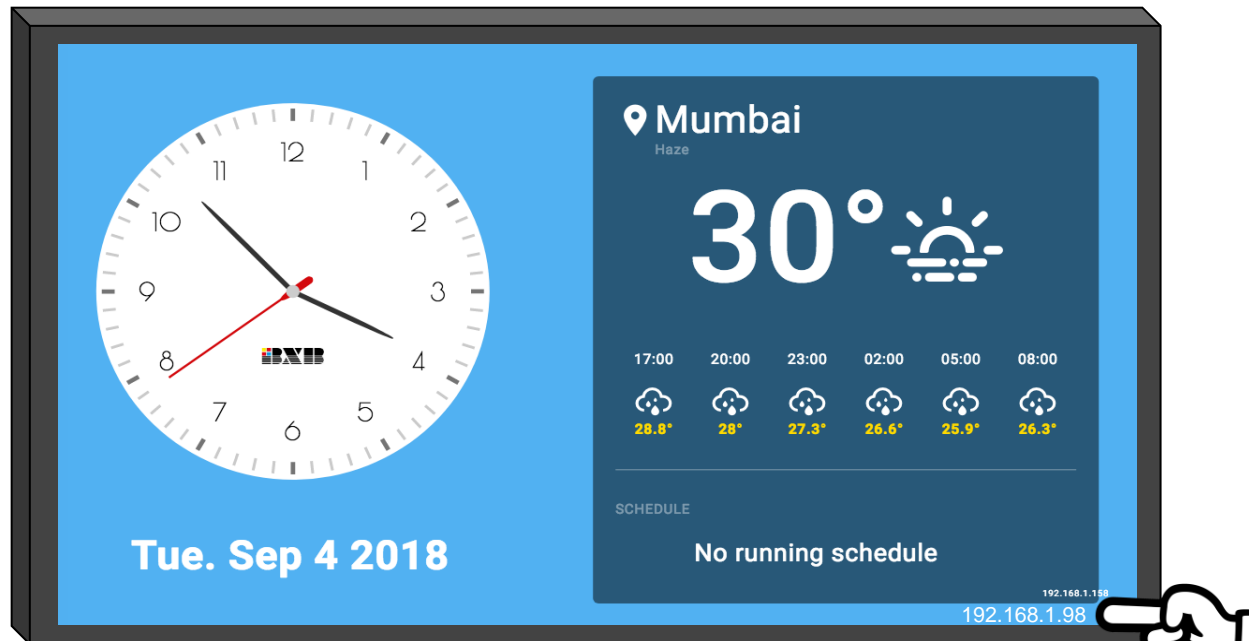
Beside audio warning, the messages would also be shown on the connected monitors.

Advanced Setting- Network

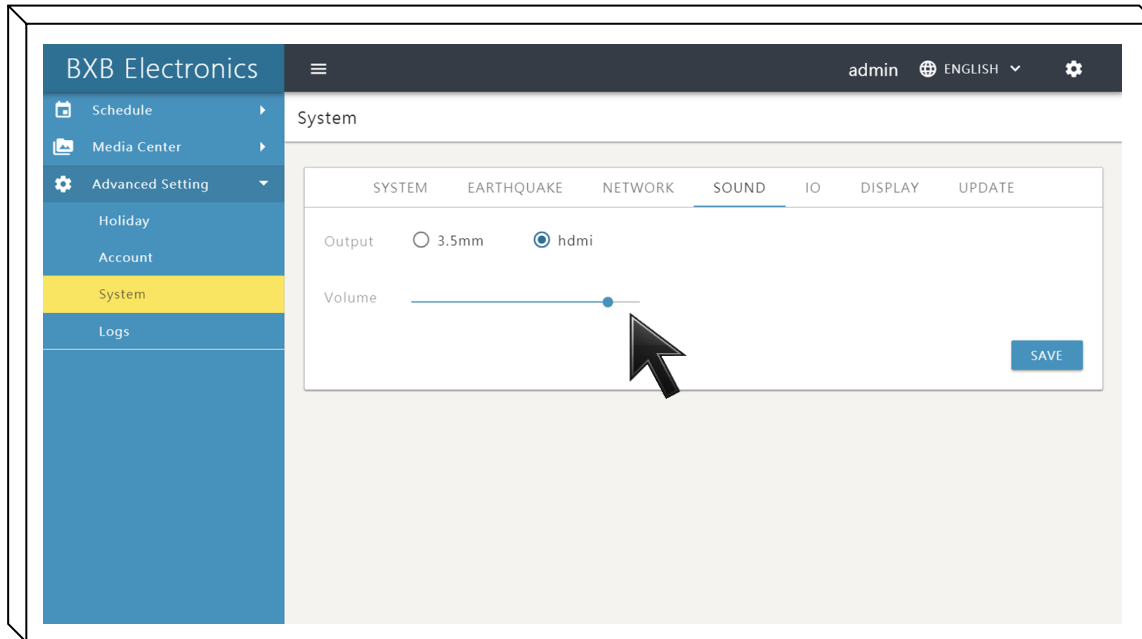


On the “NETWORK” setting page, you can set the MT-2’s IP address as “DHCP” or “fixed IP”.

The IP address can be shown on the display monitors, which facilitates administrator’s remote control.

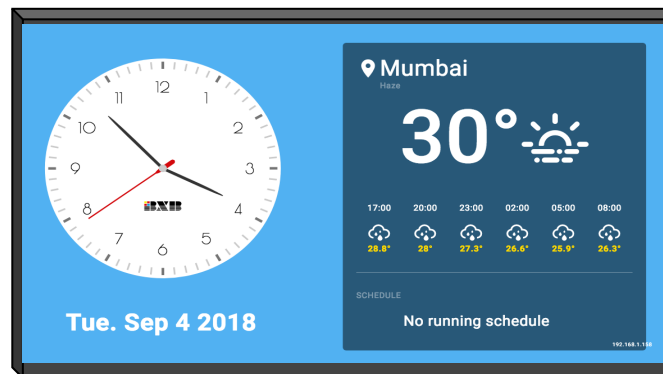
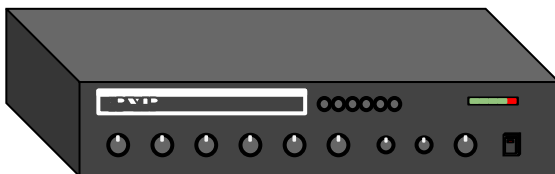


MT-2’s IP address can be shown on the screen.

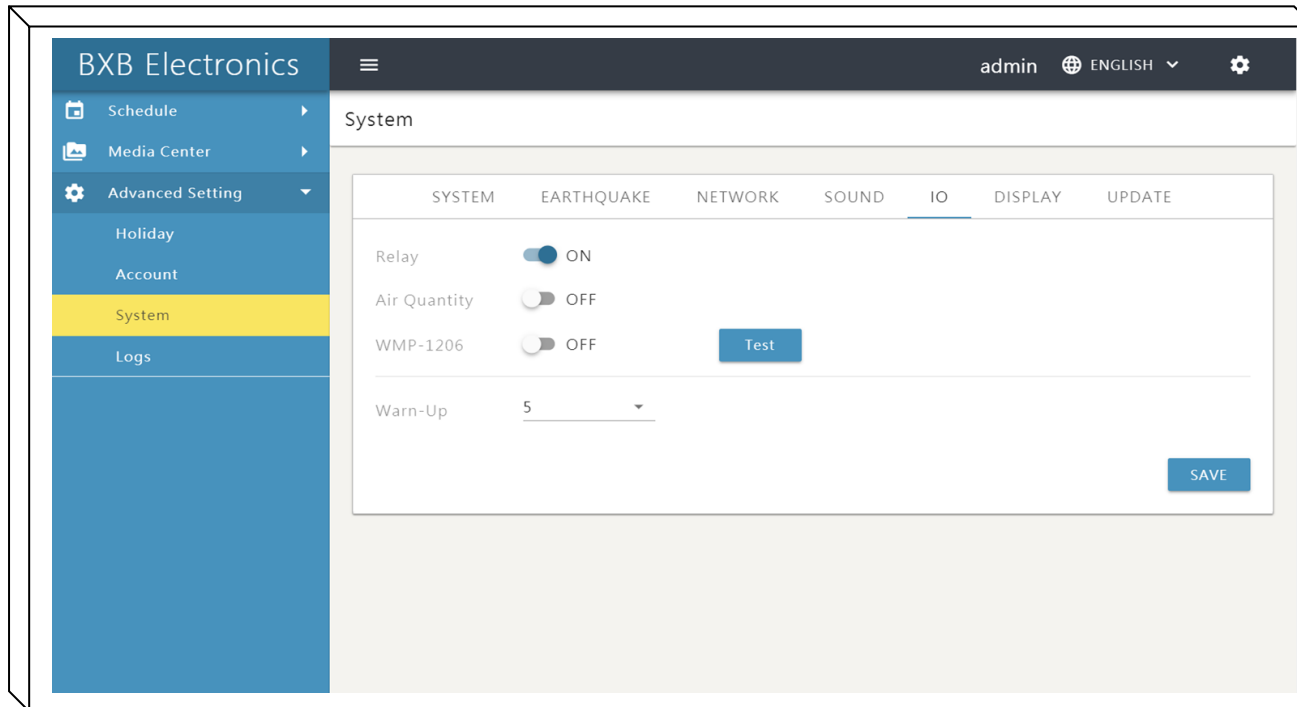


MT-2 supports either “3.5mm” or “HDMI mix” output modes.

For example, if you set the audio output as 3.5mm and MT-2 is connected with the PA system, the media sound would be only outputted to the loudspeakers of the PA system. The connected monitors (HDMI) would not have the sound.



MT-2 only supports either “3.5mm” or “HDMI mix” output.



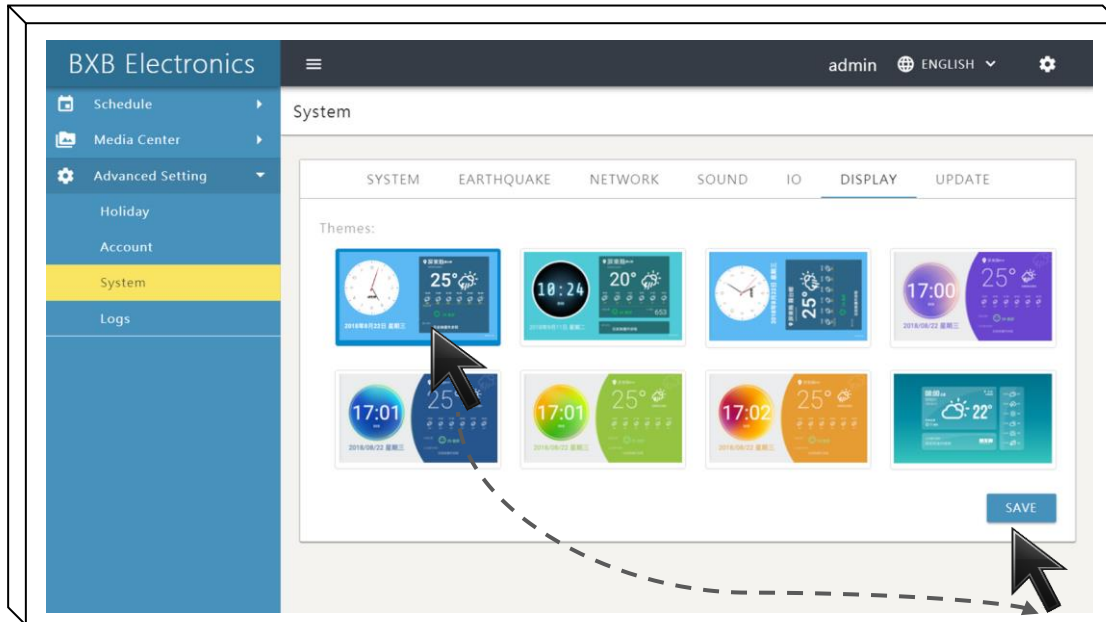
You can set multiple extension functions on “IO” page.

By connecting MT-2 with PA system, N.O. signal trigger can control the power of the terminal equipment.

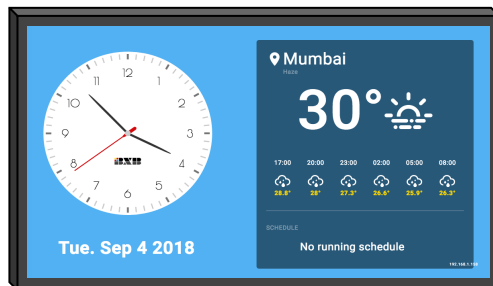
After setting the “Warm-up” time, MT-2 would turn on before it executes the schedule broadcasting. It ensures the normal operation of audio output.

Turn ON/OFF for the HDMI display of air quality.

Switch ON/OFF of BXB’s WMP-1206 to have extension functions via RS-232 port.



The monitor can show the local time, weather, air quality, and the status of the executing schedules. There're various display styles for your choices. Based on the monitor's installation modes (horizontal or vertical), you can select the way of display.



You can select various display styles based on your demands and monitor's installation modes (horizontal/vertical).
